### Steps to follow

- Commit to respecting human rights and integrate that commitment into Slingsintt.
- Identify your human rights risks
- Take actions to avoid and repair the risks you have identified
- Propose a remedy for those affected if directly involved in a negative impact
- Track your progress
- Communicate what you are doing

### At the company level

- Promote a work environment in which people respect each other
- Have measures to avoid and combat discrimination in the workplace
- Take steps to protect employees from incidents such as workplace harassment, sexual harassment and other types of harassment, whether from other employees or from outsiders such as customers and suppliers
- Support workers who claim to have been exposed to incidents of workplace harassment, sexual harassment, or similar situations
- Ensure that salaries are paid regularly and on time

### Healthy and safe work environment

- Ensure that workers have received instructions and training on how to handle substances and what to do in the event of an accident
- Ensure worker access to first aid equipment
- Conduct regular inspections to ensure health and safety requirements are met
- Ensure that substances are disposed of or stored safely after use
- Ensure that machines or vehicles used at Slingsintt are safe and regularly check their safety features
- Ensure that all workers who use that machinery or vehicles are adequately trained and authorized to use them
- Teach how to respond to a breakdown or malfunction of machinery
